Activities: Safe and stimulating activities both on and off site. They include horse riding, a canal boat trip and visits to a birds of prey display, the Tricycle Theatre and Kentish town fire station. On site activities include t-shirt designing, tile painting, bouncy castle, cooking, outdoor sports and party games with prizes.
