

It is important to know what time the register close's at your child's school. This will be outlined in the school's attendance policy. This is available from both the school's office or on the school's website.

If your child regularly arrives after this time it is recorded as an unauthorised late arrival, which could result in a Penalty Notice being issued.

Penalty Notices are issued at a cost of £60.00 per parent, per child. If unpaid after 21 days, this increases to £120.00 for a further 7 days. If unpaid after that time, you may be taken to court.
