



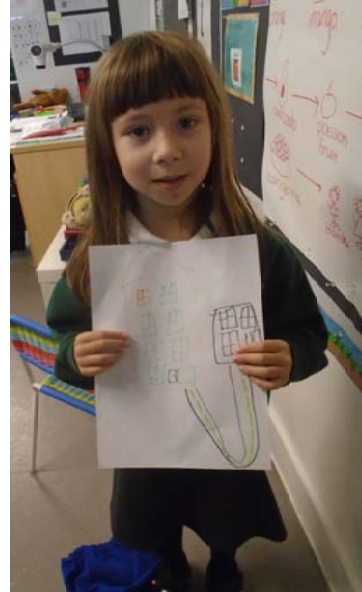

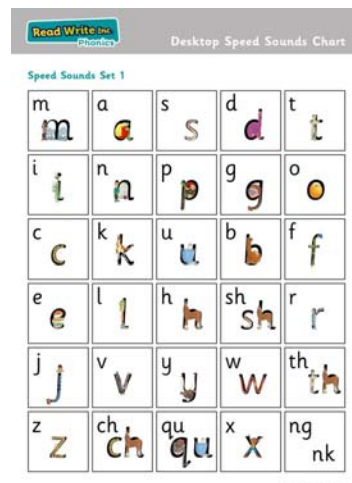
We have learnt all the single sounds. We are now

Characteristics of Effective Learning

Characteristic 1: Finding out and exploring

Does your child use imaginative play? Do they pretend objects are other things? For example, a box is a car? Do they pretend to go to places or pretend to be different people? For example, a doctor or an animal?

This means they are 'finding out and exploring' and becoming an effective learner.

I play with what I know, like Little Miss Curious.



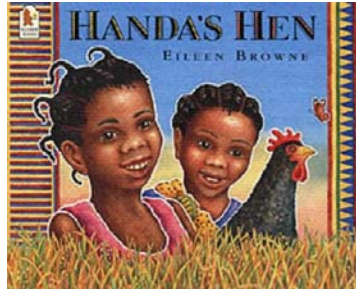
Playing and exploring: Playing with what they know.

peered pots bloom footprints long

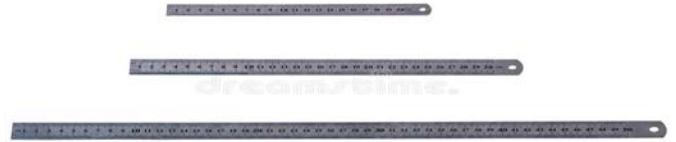


Please label all PE and school clothes so we can return them to the right children if they are lost.

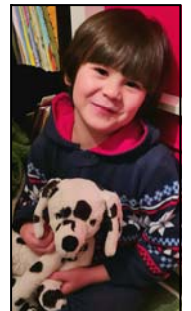
