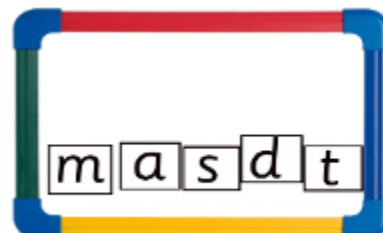


Phonics

Click on Fred to practice reading the sounds.



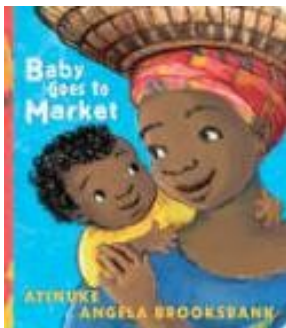
Click on the sounds to practice blending.

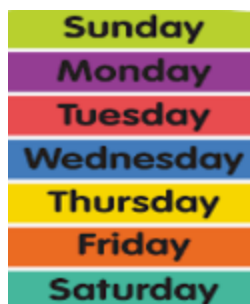
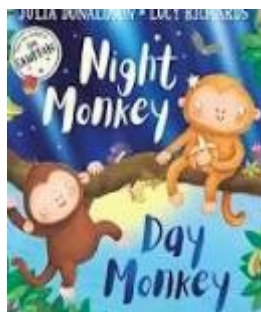
