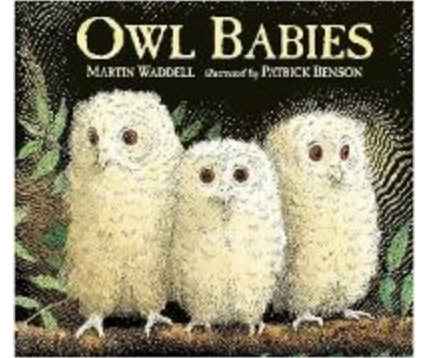




## Next week in Reception
