This week we learnt the sounds v, y, w, y and x. Click on the letter to watch the video.

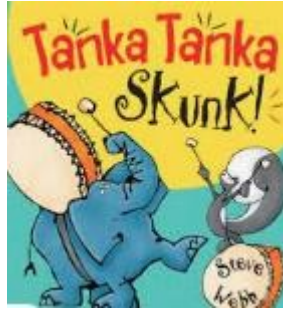




Next week in Reception

Songs, Rhymes and Poems

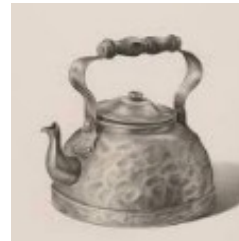
We will be learning the nursery rhyme 'Polly Put the Kettle on'. Click on the link to listen and sing the nursery rhyme.
