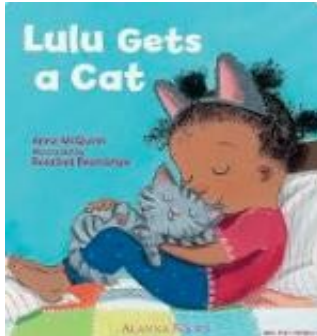




After the Easter holiday in Nursery

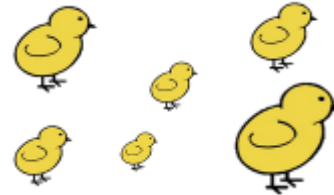
Literacy
